Being Odin's son, it could indicate that his real name could possibly be "Thor". Other known sons of Odin in are Tyr and Baldr. Though many believe Loki is a son of Odin this is only true in the comic representation of the Gods. In the actual religious belief (called Heathenism) Loki is a sworn blood brother of Odin. It is unknown who his mother is.
